Recruitment Update

We have now randomised 24 patients to CADISS and an additional 15 patients to the non-randomised arm. Congratulations to Western General Hospital, Edinburgh for recruiting their first patient and also to Sheffield, who are continuing to recruit and have now randomised 5 patients. We hope the newly activated centres will start recruiting soon. Do remember the study is adopted by the Stroke Research Network so SRN resources can be used to identify and recruit patients. At St George's since CADISS has started we have been looking particularly hard for dissection and have seen about 20 in the last year so it seems to be more common than we have previously thought.
