

Biomedical Science BSc (Hons)

Entry requirements for those sitting alternatives to A Level within EU/EEA

Scottish Framework

Candidates must offer three Advanced Highers including Chemistry and Biology with grades BBB.

European Baccalaureate

We would expect an overall grade of 75%/7.5 with similar grades in Biology and Chemistry.

Irish Leaving Certificate

6 Highers at B2 grade (in a single sitting) including Maths, English, Chemistry and Biology. Candidates should also declare their Junior Cert grades on their UCAS form.

Greece

We would expect an overall average of 17.5 in the Apolytirion with similar grades in Chemistry, Biology and English.

Entry requirements for those sitting alternatives to A Level outside EU/EEA

International applications are considered on an individual basis as they differ so widely between and within countries (depending on province, territory and state). Please note that although UK NARIC may verify that your qualification meets the overall academic condition, there is no guarantee that it will meet our entry requirements as we may consider marks in individual subjects (especially English Language, Maths and Science) and the admissions tutor's decision is final.

If your qualifications are not listed below, we will require a certificate of comparability for all completed qualifications from UK Naric (www.naric.org.uk). The certificate(s) of comparability should be sent to the Admissions Office after submission of the UCAS form with copies of all academic certificates awarded to date, as well as educational transcripts detailing marks achieved in each subject/module in addition to the overall grade.

UK Naric will not provide this service for qualifications that are pending and if this is the case, candidates should also include up to date transcripts for qualifications still in progress and referees must provide predicted grades. We would also require candidates to enclose details of the level of attainment required in such examinations to be granted entry to medical school in their own country. All documents and certificates not written in the English language must be officially translated.

The following are the general levels of attainment we expect from candidates applying from some other countries. However, as stated, candidates are assessed on an individual basis upon application:

We only accept UK Naric verification and candidates must obtain the above for their application to be considered.

America

The High School Graduation Diploma is equivalent to GCSE in the UK and cannot be considered on its own. In addition, priority is given to those who are supplementing both of the above with Advanced Placements. St George's requires at least 4 APs at grades 4,4,4,4 and should include Chemistry and Biology.

Canada

The minimum considered is the Year 12 Certificate/Diploma (with the exception of Quebec). These are assessed upon application as much is dependent upon which Province a candidate is studying in. Generally, applicants should offer an average of 65% or better overall with individual grades of 70% or better in Chemistry, English, Mathematics and Biology as individual subjects. St George's will give priority to those also undertaking Advanced Placements. Refer to details for American applicants for more information about APs.

Malaysia

Candidates must offer Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) with grades of 1 or 2 (Distinction) in lieu of GCSE grades A and B (although English is not accepted and candidates must undertake an English test). The SPM must be offered in conjunction with the Sigil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM). St George's requires at least three subjects at STPM with grades BBC. Chemistry and Biology must be offered at STPM level.

Singapore/Hong Kong/Sri Lanka/Brunei

O and A Levels directly equivalent to UK system. We require average of A-C at GCSE/O-level and ABB at A-level. If the General Paper is compulsory, we expect B3 or higher and this grade must be included in any application (predicted or achieved). In addition, we require A1 in English at GCSE/O-level. All other countries are assessed on application, but must meet UK entry requirements.
