10 Years of Bridges Self-Management

Founded from a 15-year programme of healthcare research at Kingston and St George's University of London, Bridges launched as a social enterprise spin out company in 2013. Bridges has trained more than 10,000 healthcare professionals across multiple NHS pathways, by changing the way healthcare teams work with patients with long-term conditions. Starting in stroke, Bridges has also been evaluated in major trauma, brain injury, MS, cancer and more recently in long Covid. Speaking about the novelty of Bridges, Professor Fiona Jones, Founder and CEO says:
