PERSONAL TUTOR MEETINGS FOR MBBS The one-page guide for personal tutors

Frequency of Meetings: two compulsory meetings per year

All meetings are recorded by the Personal Tutor using **Myprogress** online forms as part of the 'Being a Doctor' assessment. Students access this via electronic devices using their SGUL sign in and **send them to their tutor**. Students should **not** complete this themselves. Meetings should be **face to face in-person** or **online using Teams**. If possible, have an informal **introductory meet & greet group meeting** with **Year 1** tutees before **week 4** of their course (not recorded on Myprogress), prior to the individual meeting later in Term 1.

- Explore longer-term goals (research, further study, careers)



Welfare "check": any difficulties impacting on studies?

- Pastoral role provide individual support for wellbeing
- Explore any issues and refer to specialist support as required *eg* finance, housing
 Act as advocate if required e.g advice on mitigating circumstances, letter of support at panel hearings, point of contact, advice on referral to other services



Extra-curricular engagement

- •Explore and signpost enhancement opportunities, internally via SGUL or externally.
- •Reflect on professional identity and explore career interests.
- Provide references (part-time jobs, volunteer work, Foundation Programme)
