#### WHO IS THIS PROGRAMME FOR?

Health and social care practitioners from all professional backgrounds and practice settings.

#### **PROGRAMME SUMMARY**

This flexible programme is designed to provide postgraduate level health and social care education and permits a high level of student choice. There are 2 compulsory research elements. The remainder of the programme is selected by the student. Up to 120 credits of prior certificated learning may be considered.

Mode of study: Full time over 1 year or part-time, normally over 3 years.
