Nurses working within intensive care.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

This flexible programme is designed to provide specialist post-graduate level education for nurses working within intensive care, which can be supplemented with a free choice of further specialist or professional modules.

Mode of study: Part-time, normally over 3 years.

Phase 1: PG Certificate Healthcare Practice (Intensive Care)

Intensive Care Patient Management 30 CREDITS (Compulsory)

Phase 2: PG Diploma Healthcare Practice (Intensive Care)

Research Methods 15 CREDITS (Compulsory)

Choice of optional modules (45 Credits), including:

12 Lead ECG Interpretation 15 CREDITS
Intensive Care of the Polytrauma 15 CREDITS
Acutely unwell adult 30 CREDITS

Research Dissertation or 60 CREDITS
Critical Review or 60 CREDITS
Work-based project 60 CREDITS
