APPLICATIONS:

Applications close on Monday 7 June 2021 (30 April 2021 in order to be considered for scholarship funding or early bird discount). You will be informed of the outcome of your application no later than two weeks after your submission, you will then be prompted to submit your payment through the online store. We advise you not to book your flights until you have completed your payment and have a confirmed place on the summer school.

IMMIGRATION INFORMATION:

HOW TO MAKE YOUR PAYMENT:

Please use the University's online payment system at <http://shop.sgul.ac.uk/product-catalogue>. Please note that some card providers limit the amount that can be paid online, so you may need to speak with your provider to clear the payment first.

- Under the **Navigation** heading on the left hand side of the screen, select **Short Courses**, then click on **Professional Education** and then choose **Summer School** from the drop-down menu; click on **Read More** to read all description text; Once you have read the description text, please click on **Add to Basket**;
- A **Proceed to Basket** should appear in the top right-hand corner of your screen. Click on this or the **Shopping Basket** button at the top of the page; check the details are correct and click on the **Proceed to Checkout** link;
- In order to complete the transaction, you will need to register as a new customer and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the payment process;
- You will be sent an automated confirmation e-mail after your payment has been processed.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Applicants have the right to decline their place on the programme until **16 June 2021**, without any financial penalty.

The official start date of the Summer School is **Monday 12 July 2021**. If you wish to withdraw from the Summer School, the following withdrawal policies are in place:

- If you withdraw before the withdrawal deadline (**16 June 2021**), any tuition fees, housing and social programme payments received will be refunded in full.
- If you withdraw after the withdrawal deadline but before the start of the Summer School, you will be refunded 50% of the tuition fee.
- You will not receive a refund for housing fees or your social programme payment if you withdraw once the Summer School has begun on **Monday 12 July 2021**. Unfortunately at this stage no course fees, accommodation or social programme payments can be refunded.
